One of the objectives of this workshop will be to highlight the opportunities to transfer innovative actions developed in other territories to Luxembourg and to develop collaborations in the field of Elderly People Mobility.

The European Mobility Partnership ICMA - Improving Connectivity and Mobility Access - is a project funded by the European Regional Development Fund (ERDF) under the INTERREG IVB NWE programme (2008-2012). The project is led by Transport for Greater Manchester (TfGM).

In the framework of this ICMA project, a transnational "Train the Trainer" action has been developed. It is a training programme conceived by the Swiss mobility agency Rundum Mobil (Thun). This action is targeting travel trainers for seniors and testing how to transfer a training programme into the organisational, cultural and institutional framework of other countries. This approach has been implemented in 8 European cities, which include the city of Offenbach.

***During this workshop, Anja Georgi, director of NiO (Nahverkehr in Offenbach), will present the actions which have taken place in Offenbach for senior citizens (train the trainer, passenger information for seniors...). A key issue of the presentation will be to highlight the conditions of transferability of these actions to another territory.***

For the discussion afterwards how the "Train the Trainer" tool could be adopted to the Luxembourgish context a wide range of organisations from Luxembourg have been invited being in charge of public transport and/or dealing with issues for elderly people. **Don't miss this excellent networking opportunity!**

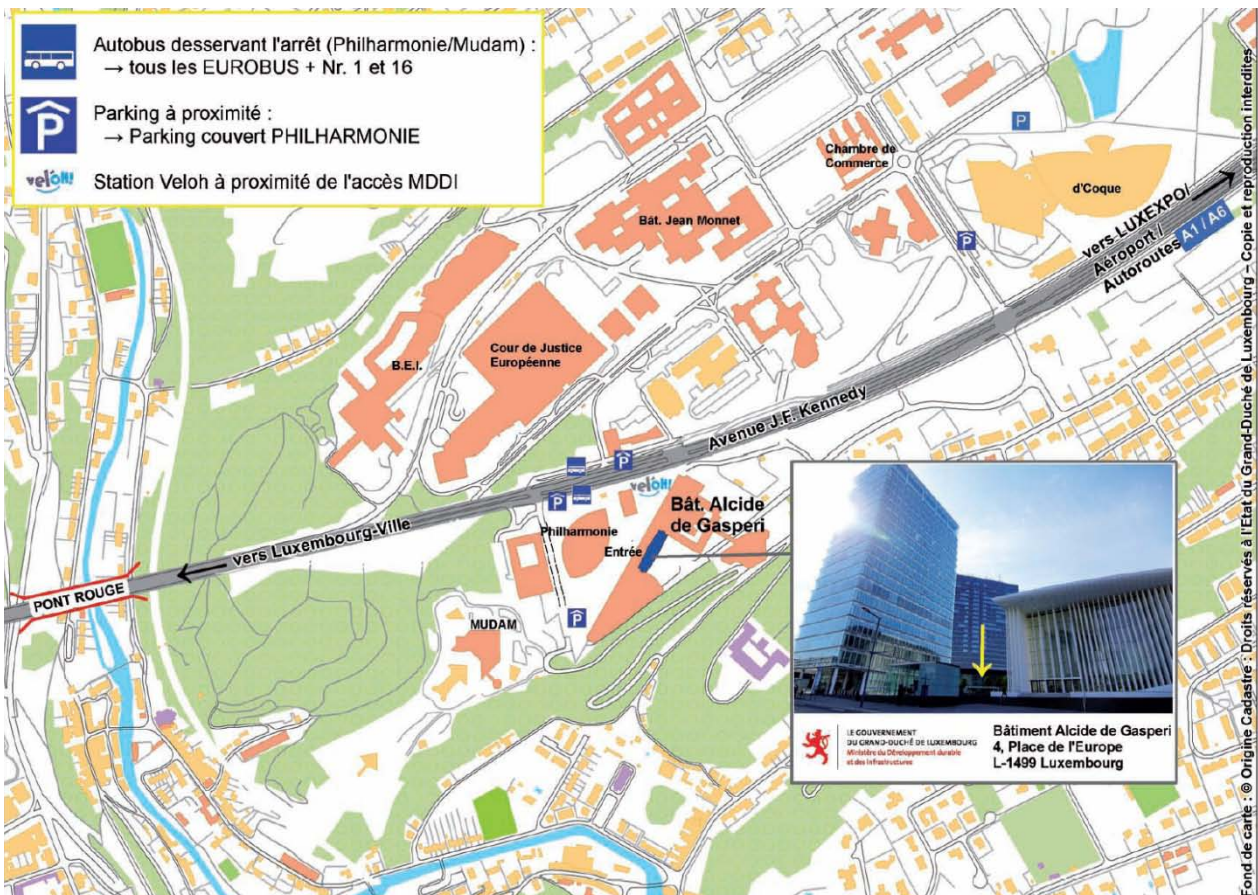
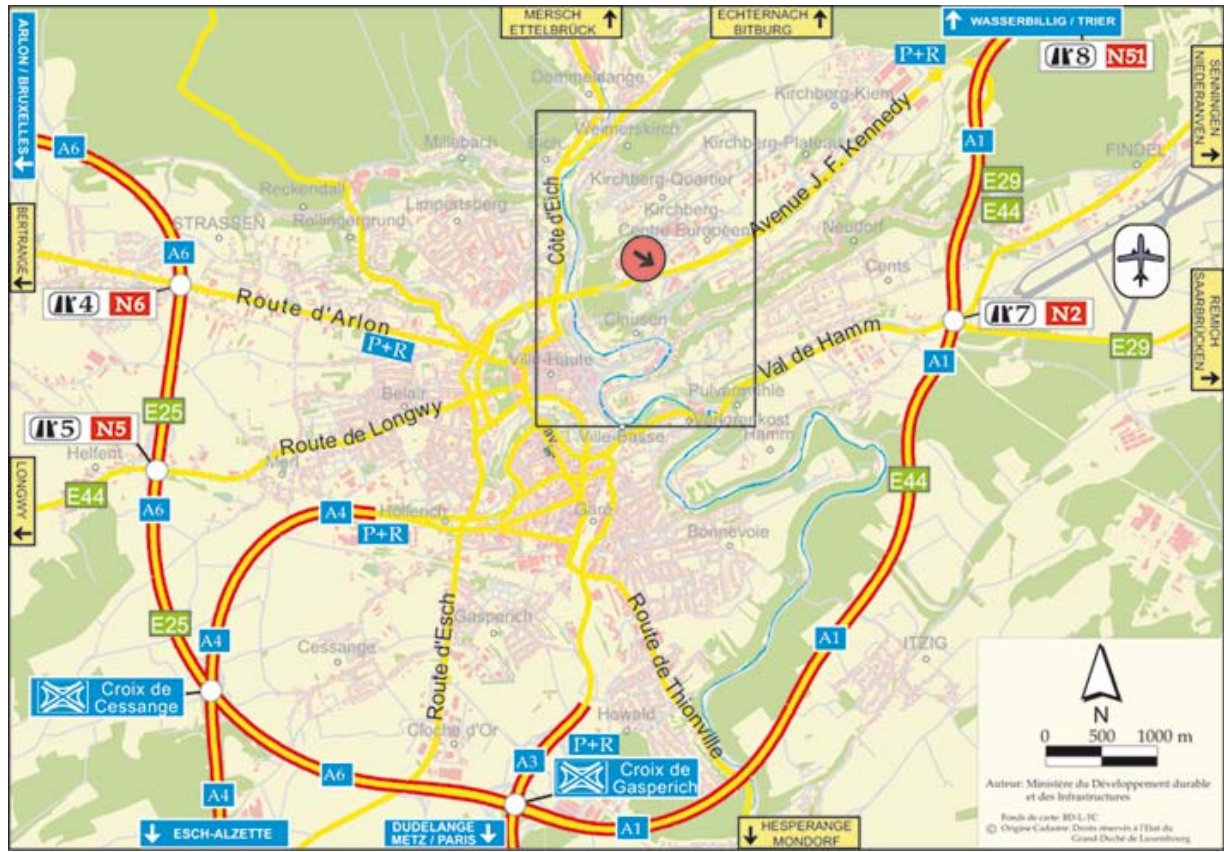
